

# LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

*(Brought in by Mr Stockdale and Mr Kennett)*

## A BILL

to make interim appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund for recurrent services and for certain works and purposes for the period July to October 1994.

### **Appropriation (Interim 1994–95) Act 1994**

**The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:**

**1. *Purpose***

The purpose of this Act is to appropriate certain sums and supplies for the period July to October 1994.

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**2. *Commencement***

This Act comes into operation on 1 July 1994.

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Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act.  
(See **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**.)

3. Definitions

In this Act—

“works” means the construction, replacement, renovation, renewal, protection, development or surveying of and maintenance, alterations or improvements to buildings, structures, forests, waterworks or other properties, the purchase of land, buildings or property and the provision, alteration etc. of furniture, fittings, plant, machinery, equipment, tools and vehicles and expenditure incidental to those activities.

4. Application of moneys

(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Fund in respect of the period commencing on 1 July 1994 and ending on 31 October 1994 the sum of four thousand seven hundred and twenty two million and fifty one thousand dollars as set out in Schedule 1 for recurrent services and works and services.

(2) If—

(a) during the period commencing on 1 July 1994 and ending on 31 October 1994 the amount payable in respect of salaries is increased as the result of any act or determination made after 31 March 1994; and

(b) the relevant amounts specified in Schedule 1 are insufficient to provide for the payment of the increased amount payable in respect of salaries—

the Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply for recurrent services such amounts not exceeding in total the increased amount payable in respect of salaries.

(3) In sub-section (2)—

“salaries” includes wages or other payments in the nature of salary, payments by way of overtime

or penalty rates or in lieu of long service leave  
or for retiring gratuities;

5       “**determination**” includes any regulation or any  
award order or determination of a person or  
body authorised to determine minimum salaries  
or wages under any law of the Commonwealth  
or of the State.

- (4) The Consolidated Fund is appropriated to the extent  
necessary for the purposes of this section.

10       **5. *Appropriation of certain receipts***

If it is provided that this section applies in relation to  
an item of expenditure of a department set out in  
Schedule 1, money received—

- 15       (a) from the provision of services by that  
department; or  
(b) by way of specific purpose payment by the  
Commonwealth—

20       may be credited to that item to the extent, and on the  
conditions, agreed between the Treasurer and the  
Minister responsible for the administration of that  
item, and for that purpose—

- (a) an amount equal to that amount so credited is  
deemed to have been appropriated for the  
purposes of that item; and  
25       (b) the Treasurer may issue the amount out of the  
Consolidated Fund and apply it accordingly.
