A BILL

to enable Australian Airlines Limited to operate air services within Victoria, to repeal the Air Navigation Act 1958 and for other purposes.

Australian Airlines (Intrastate Services) Act 1990

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purposes

5

- 1. The purposes of this Act are—
 - (a) to enable Australian Airlines Limited and its subsidiaries to operate air services within Victoria; and
 - (b) to repeal the Air Navigation Act 1958.

Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

10 Adoption of section 54 of the Commonwealth Act

3. Section 54 of the Australian Airlines (Conversion to Public Company) Act 1988 of the Commonwealth is adopted.

Repeal of Air Navigation Act 1958

4. The Air Navigation Act 1958 is repealed.
