Burrumbeet and for other purposes.

Burrumbeet Land Act 1990

Preamble:

Land at Burrumbeet was permanently reserved for the purposes
of water supply and is no longer required for that purpose:

It is proposed to lease the land to its present occupier:

- 5 To enable this to be done it is proposed to revoke the permanent
reservation of that land.

The Parliament of Victoria therefore enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

- 10 The purpose of this Act is to revoke the permanent
reservation of land at Burrumbeet.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act
(see **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

3. Removal of reservation

The Order in Council specified in the Schedule is revoked.

4. Land deemed to be unalienated Crown land

5

Despite anything to the contrary in any Act or law, the land described in the Schedule is deemed to be unalienated land of the Crown, freed and discharged from all trusts, limitations, reservations, restrictions, encumbrances, estates and interests.

5. No compensation payable by the Crown

No compensation is payable by the Crown in respect of anything done under or arising out of this Act.
