A BILL

to amend the **Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978** and for other purposes.

Chiropractors and Osteopaths (Amendment) Act 1990

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purposes of this Act are—

- 5 (a) to clarify the powers and immunities vested in the
 Chiropractors and Osteopaths Registration Board;
 and
- (b) to make several minor amendments to the
 Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978.

2. Commencement

- 10 This Act comes into operation on the day on which it
 receives the Royal Assent.

(see **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**).

3. *Repeal of table of Parts*

In section 1 of the **Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978**, sub-section (3) is repealed.

4. *Amendment of section 8*

In section 8 (5) of the **Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978**, after “20” insert “, 21A”.

5. *Amendment of section 14*

In section 14 (1) of the **Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978**, for “section 13” substitute “sections 13 and 13A”.
