# Chiropractors and Osteopaths (Amendment) Act 1990

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

#### 1. Purpose

The purposes of this Act are—

- (a) to clarify the powers and immunites vested in the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Registration Board; and
- (b) to make several minor amendments to the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978.

#### 2. Commencement

#### 3. Repeal of table of Parts

### 4. Amendment of section 8

In section 14 (1) of the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1978, for "section 13" substitute "sections 13 and 13A".
