to make various amendments to the **Dentists Act 1972** and for other purposes.

Dentists (Amendment) Act 1994

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to amend the **Dentists Act** 1972 to—

- (a) include a power of entry; and
- (b) amend the regulation making powers.

2. Commencement

(1) Section 1 and this section come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

Section headings appear in bold italics and are not part of the Act. (See Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984.)

the issue of a search warrant, if that person believes, on reasonable grounds—

- (a) that there is or has been a contravention of this Act or the regulations on any premises; or
- (b) that entry into or onto any premises is necessary for the purpose of investigating whether or not the registration of a dentist should be suspended or cancelled.
- (2) A magistrate to whom such an application is made, if satisfied by evidence on oath or by affidavit that there are reasonable grounds for doing so, may issue a search warrant in accordance with the Magistrates' Court Act 1989.
- (3) In addition to those matters authorised by section 78 of the Magistrates' Court Act 1989, a search warrant issued under sub-section (2) authorises the person to whom it is directed to inspect and take photographs (including video recordings) or make sketches, of the premises or anything at the premises."
