Estate Agents (Amendment) Act 1986

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose.

1. The purpose of this Act is to make further provision for the membership of the Estate Agents Board.

5 Commencement.

2. This Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

Principal Act.

3. In this Act, the Estate Agents Act 1980 is called the Principal Act.

Estate Agents Board.

- 4. (1) In section 6 (2) of the Principal Act, for paragraphs (c) and (d) substitute—
 - "(c) three shall be appointed from a panel submitted by the Real Estate Institute of Victoria of names of eight persons who have for the previous five years been licensed estate agents practising as such;".

- (2) In section 6 (10) of the Principal Act omit "(d)".

Transitional provisions.

- 5. (1) Every member of the Estate Agents Board holding office pursuant to section 6 (2) (c) or (d) of the Principal Act immediately before the commencement of this Act shall continue to hold office as if appointed pursuant to the Principal Act as amended by this Act.
- (2) The term of appointment of any person continuing to hold office under sub-section (1) shall remain the same term as fixed by the Governor in Council in the instrument of appointment pursuant to section 6 (5) of the Principal Act.
- (3) Notwithstanding the reconstitution of the Estate Agents Board effected by this Act the Board is the same body after as before the commencement of section 4 (1) and no act matter or thing is abated thereby.
