to amend the Lotteries Gaming and Betting Act 1966 and the Stamps Act 1958 and for other purposes.

# Lotteries Gaming and Betting (Betting) Act 1994

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to amend the Lotteries Gaming and Betting Act 1966 and the Stamps Act 1958 with respect to illegal betting.

#### 2. Commencement

(1) Section 1 and this section come into operation on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.
