A BILL

to provide for the transfer of certain Commonwealth officers to the Victorian Public Service and for other purposes.

Quarantine Officers (Transfer) Act 1990

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

Purpose

1. The purpose of this Act is to provide for the transfer of certain Commonwealth officers to the Victorian Public Service.

5 **Commencement**

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives Royal Assent.

Definitions

3. In this Act—

10 “**Appointed Day**” means the day fixed by the Minister under section 4.

Appointed Day

15 4. The Minister may, by notice published in the *Government Gazette*, fix a day as the day on which the transfer of certain Commonwealth officers to the Victorian Public Service takes effect.

Quarantine Officers (Transfer)

Transferred officers

5. For the purposes of this Act, "Transferred officer" means a person—

- (a) nominated in writing to the Minister before the Appointed Day by the Executive Director of the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service; and 5
- (b) who, immediately before the Appointed Day, was employed in general quarantine duties as an officer in the Commonwealth Public Service; and
- (c) who, before the Appointed Day, elects by notice in writing given to the Executive Director of the Australian Quarantine and Inspection Service to transfer to the Victorian Public Service. 10

Transfer of officers

6. (1) On the Appointed Day, the transferred officers become officers of the public service. 15

(2) The salary of a transferred officer is the salary determined by the Public Service Board but must not be less than the salary to which the transferred officer was entitled immediately before the Appointed Day. 20

(3) A transferred officer has the other entitlements, emoluments, classifications and accrued benefits determined by the Public Service Board.
