## A BILL

## AN ACT

To amend the *Teaching Service Act* 1958 and for other purposes.

B it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Teaching Service* Short title. (Amendment) Act 1968.
- (2) In this Act the Teaching Service Act 1958 is called the Principal Act.

- 2. Section 44 of the Principal Act shall be amended as follows:— Amendment of No. 6391 s. 44.
  - (a) For paragraphs (c) and (d) there shall be substituted the following paragraphs:—
  - "(c) prescribe annual increments for any class or grade or, in the case of temporary teachers, increments which are to be received at any specified intervals;

- (d) prescribe in respect of any position or class of positions or any employment in the teaching service a salary or wage, or a salary or wage range (with provision for annual increments or, in the case of temporary employment, increments at any specified intervals), within the minimum and maximum limits of a class or grade;
- (da) prescribe different annual rates of salary or different ranges of annual rates of salary for persons within any class or grade having any prescribed qualifications; 10
- (db) prescribe qualifications to be possessed or conditions to be fulfilled by any person before being eligible to be placed in or promoted to a specified subdivision of any class or to be paid more than a specified salary;
- (dc) prescribe a higher salary or higher salaries to be paid a person in any specified class according to the nature of his experience in the class or any change in the nature of the responsibilities of any position held by him."
