A BILL

To repeal the *Wyndham Shire Hall Act 1892*

Whereas by the *Wyndham Shire Hall Act 1892* it was among other provisions enacted that the President Councillors and Ratepayers of the Shire of Wyndham (now known as the Shire of Werribee) should purchase a site for the erection of buildings within the Shire of
5 Wyndham to be used only for a Shire Hall and municipal offices and for offices and conveniences connected therewith and if no longer required for those purposes for the site to become Crown Land:

And whereas a site was purchased and buildings erected for the above purposes:

10 And whereas that site and the buildings thereon are no longer required for use as a Shire Hall and municipal offices:

And whereas it is desired that the former Shire Hall be used or leased for community purposes and that the remainder of the site be leased or sold by the corporation of the Shire of Werribee.

15 And whereas it is expedient to remove the restrictions upon the purposes for which the site and buildings might be used:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present
20 Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Werribee Shire Hall Act 1983*.

Commencement.

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

2. The *Wyndham Shire Hall Act 1892* is hereby repealed.
