

Burrumbeet Land Bill
EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
NOTES ON CLAUSES

Clause 1 states that the purpose of the Bill is to revoke the permanent reservation of land at Burrumbeet.

Clause 2 provides that the Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.

Clause 3 provides that the Order in Council permanently reserving land for water supply purposes at Burrumbeet is revoked.

Clause 4 provides that following revocation of the permanent reservation the land will be deemed to be unalienated Crown land.

Clause 5 provides that no compensation is payable by the Crown for anything arising out of this Act.

Schedule describes Burrumbeet land.
