## Credit (Amendment) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 states the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 contains the commencement provisions.

Clause 3 validates certain forms of refinanced loan contracts.

Clause 4 exempts foreign credit unions from the Credit Act 1984.

Clause 5 validates certain loans made by foreign credit unions.

Clause 6 amends the Credit Act 1984 and Credit (Administration) Act 1984 to remove the exemptions for credit unions.

Clause 7 provides for a minor amendment to the Credit Act 1984.
