## Constitution (Supreme Court) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 states the purpose of the Bill.
- Clause 2 is a commencement provision.
- Clause 3 refers to the Constitution Act 1975 as the Principal Act.
- Clause 4 inserts a new provision which defines the circumstances in which an Act will exclude the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court or repeal, alter or vary the provisions of Part III of the Principal Act.
- Clause 5 limits the grounds on which certain legislation can be called into question in legal proceedings.
