Crimes (Grand Juries) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Act.

Clause 2 provides for the Act to commence on Royal Assent.

Clause 3 abolishes grand juries and makes consequential amendments to section 351 of the Crimes Act 1958 and section 39 of the Juries Act 1967.

Clause 4 is a transitional provision.
