Dentists (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Outline

The aim of this legislation is to make a number of amendments to improve the operation of the Dentists Act 1972.

In particular, the Bill will-

- (a) enable the incorporation of standards, codes or other documents into the Dentists Regulations 1992; and
- (b) give the Board the power to enter any premises with a search warrant for the purpose of investigating a breach of the Act or the regulations.

Clause Notes

Clause 1 describes the purposes of the Act.

Clause 2 is the commencement provision.

Clause 3 defines the Dentists Act 1972 as being the Principal Act.

Clause 4 amends the regulation making power by enabling the incorporation of standards, codes or other documents into the regulations.

Clause 5 gives the Board the power to make application to a magistrate for the issue of a search warrant where there are reasonable grounds for believing that a breach of the Act or the regulations has occurred or there has been a breach of the terms of registration.
