

Education Acts (Overseas Students) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 describes the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides that the Act will come into operation on 1 July 1989.

Clause 3 amends the *Education Act 1958* by providing a process for endorsing schools as suitable for overseas students.

Clause 4 makes provision in the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978* for the endorsement of courses of study for overseas students at post-secondary education institutions.

Clause 5 provides for the delegation of the Minister's power to endorse courses for overseas students to the Victorian Post-Secondary Education Commission.

Clause 6 enables the power to endorse courses for overseas students to be delegated to a body established under section 15A of the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*.

Clause 7 makes statute law revision amendments to the *Post-Secondary Education Act 1978*.
