Education Acts (Overseas Students) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 describes the purpose of the Bill.
- Clause 2 provides that the Act will come into operation on 1 July 1989.
- Clause 3 amends the Education Act 1958 by providing a process for endorsing schools as suitable for overseas students.
- Clause 4 makes provision in the Post-Secondary Education Act 1978 for the endorsement of courses of study for overseas students at post-secondary education institutions.
- Clause 5 provides for the delegation of the Minister's power to endorse courses for overseas students to the Victorian Post-Secondary Education Commission.
- Clause 6 enables the power to endorse courses for overseas students to be delegated to a body established under section 15A of the Post-Secondary Education Act 1978.
- Clause 7 makes statute law revision amendments to the Post-Secondary Education Act 1978.
