

Education (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 describes the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the provisions of the Bill.

Clause 3 notes that the *Education Act 1958* is the Principal Act.

Clause 4 amends the Principal Act to provide for the registration of primary and secondary teachers.

Clause 5 substitutes for the existing section 52M of the Principal Act, amended provisions relating to multiple registration.

Clause 6 amends sections 52N and 52O of the Principal Act to provide for the changed types of registration.

Clause 7 contains miscellaneous statute law revision amendments to the Principal Act and the *Constitution Act 1975*.

Clause 8 safeguards the registration of teachers currently registered under Part 111A of the Principal Act.

Clause 9 extends the terms of office of members of the Teachers Registration Board.
