

## **Education (State Schools) Bill**

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

- Clause 1 sets out the main purpose of the Act.
- Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Act upon it receiving the Royal Assent.
- Clause 3 inserts a new section 25C in the **Education Act 1958** to authorise the making of regulations concerning the age requirements of persons to enrol at or attend etc State schools, and for principals and head teachers to refuse to allow a person who does not meet those age requirements to enrol at or attend etc the school.
- Clause 4 excludes the Bill from affecting the rights and obligation of the parties in the Supreme Court proceedings number 6991 of 1997.
