EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 sets out the main purpose of the Act.
- Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Act upon it receiving the Royal Assent.
- Clause 3 inserts a new section 25C in the Education Act 1958 to authorise the making of regulations concerning the age requirements of persons to enrol at or attend etc State schools, and for principals and head teachers to refuse to allow a person who does not meet those age requirements to enrol at or attend etc the school.
- Clause 4 excludes the Bill from affecting the rights and obligation of the parties in the Supreme Court proceedings number 6991 of 1997.
