Industrial Relations (Further Amendment) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

PART 1—PRELIMINARY

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Bill.

Clause 2 sets out the commencement provisions.

Clause 3 cites the Principal Act.

PART 2—HOSPITALS REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Clause 4 inserts a new section 34A into the Principal Act to empower a Conciliation and Arbitration Board to inquire into and determine terms and conditions of, appointment of and rates of remuneration of medical practitioners providing medical services under sessional contracts.

The Clause also sets out the relevant definitions.

Clause 5 repeals the Hospitals Remuneration Tribunal Act 1978.

Clause 6 provides the relevant transitional provisions.

Clause 7 makes consequential amendments to the Mental Health Act 1959.

PART 3-MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS

Clause 8 makes a minor corrective amendment to section 7 of the Principal Act.
