Land (Miscellaneous Matters) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this Bill is to revoke the permanent reservations of certain lands and to repeal the *Port Fairy Land Act* 1981.

- Clause 1 states the purpose of the Act.
- Clause 2 provides for the Act to come into operation on the day of the Royal Assent.

Clause 3

Sub-clause (1) revokes the permanent reservation of the land specified in Item 1 of Schedule 1 to the extent that it applies to the land shown hatched on the plan in Schedule 2.

Sub-clause (2) revokes the permanent reservation of the land specified in Item 2 of Schedule 1.

- Clause 4 provides for the lands of which the reservations are revoked to be unalienated land of the Crown.
 - Clause 5 repeals the Port Fairy Land Act 1981.
- Clause 6 states that no compensation is payable by the Crown as a consequence of this Act.
 - Schedule 1 specifies the reservations which are revoked.
- Schedule 2 shows by hatching on a plan the extent of the land being the part of a permanent reservation which is revoked.
