Melbourne Exhibition Centre (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Act.
- Clause 2 provides for the Act to commence on the Assent date.
- Clause 3 provides for the repeal of section 23(1) which gave the Melbourne Exhibition Centre Trust restricted powers to deal with land. The Trust will now rely on the general powers in section 5 of the Act.
- Clause 4 provides for the partial revocation of the permanent reservation of a small portion of the Melbourne Exhibition Centre land reserved for the maritime museum which is required for the purposes of the Melbourne Exhibition Centre.
