Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (Amendment) Bill

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OUTLINE

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the boundaries of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre land and to provide for the lease over that land.

- Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Act.
- Clause 2 is a commencement provision and provides that the Act will come into operation on the day it receives Royal Assent.
- Clause 3 substitutes a new definition of Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre land which provides for new boundaries.
- Clause 4 amends section 24(1) of the Principal Act to include a reference to a small area of reserved land. This clause also inserts a new section 24(3) which specifies that leases previously granted for Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre land are deemed to be leases granted for the whole of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre land as defined by Clause 3.
- Clause 5 amends the Schedule to the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre Act 1994 to include a surveyed plan of the land.

SCHEDULE

The Schedule sets out a map of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre land with the new boundaries as surveyed.
