## Occupational Health and Safety (Penalties) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- Clause 1 specifies the purpose of the Bill.
- Clause 2 specifies that the Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
- Clause 3 notes that the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1985 is the Principal Act.
- Clause 4 amends section 42 of the Principal Act to increase the penalties.
- Clause 5 amends section 44 of the Principal Act to increase the penalties.
- Clause 6 amends section 47 of the Principal Act to increase the penalties.
- Clause 7 inserts a new section 47A into the Principal Act to enable a scheme of infringement notices, by regulation.
- Clause 8 substitutes a new section 53 which provides for further penalties where a person or body corporate breaches the Act more than once.
  - Clause 9 amends section 54 of the Principal Act to increase the penalties.
- Clause 10 amends Schedule One of the Principal Act to increase the penalties allowable by regulation.

Clause 11 amends the Magistrates' Courts Act 1971 to increase the penalties prescribed under that Act in relation to offences under the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1985 and to provide for additional penalties where a person or body corporate breaches the Occupational Health and Safety Act more than once. Provision is also made for the amendment of the Magistrates' Court Act 1989.
