## Royal Agricultural Show-grounds (Amendment) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Clause 1 sets out the purpose of the Act.

Clause 2 is the commencement provision. Sections 1 and 2 come into operation on Royal Assent. The remaining provisions come into operation on a day to be proclaimed. If a provision to be proclaimed does not come into operation within 12 months beginning on, and including, the day on which the Act receives the Royal Assent, it comes into operation on the first day after the end of that period.

Clause 3 provides for the insertion of a new section 1A defining Royal Agricultural Society as R.A.S.V. Limited A.C.N. 006 728 785 (a company limited by guarantee) or if that company changes its name, that company under its new name.

Clause 4 provides for the net profits from the use of Show-grounds land to be applied, among other things for the purposes of the Royal Agricultural Society as defined.

Clause 5 inserts new sections 4, 5 and 6 in the Royal Agricultural Show-grounds Act 1931 as follows—

- (1) section 4 provides for the application of planning schemes to Show-grounds land; and
- (2) section 5 provides for the change of name from The Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria or the National Agricultural Society of Victoria to the Royal Agricultural Society, as defined, in certain instruments relating to the land; and
- (3) section 6 provides that the Registrar of Titles must make any necessary amendments in the Register because of the operation of section 5.
