

# Survey Co-ordination (Amendment) Bill

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

*Clause 1* sets out the purpose of the Act.

*Clause 2* provides for the commencement of the Act.

*Clause 3* refers to the *Survey Co-ordination Act 1958* as being the Principal Act.

*Clause 4* amends definitions in the Principal Act.

*Clause 5* makes amendments to the Act to delete reference to the Commonwealth survey authority in the development of survey standards.

*Clause 6* inserts a new section 21A into the Principal Act to provide that land information systems prepared by or on behalf of a department or public authority are based on or capable of conversion to the Australian Map Grid used in accordance with prescribed standards.

*Clause 7* provides power for regulations to be made to prescribe standards for cadastral and other survey marks.

*Clause 8* increases by one the membership of the Place Names Committee to include a representative of aboriginal interests.

*Clause 9* requires that the Place Names Committee compile and maintain a register of the names of streets and roads.
