## Shop Trading (Amendment) Bill

## **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

Clause 1 provides that the purpose of the Act is to repeal provisions requiring shops and market sites to be registered.

Clause 2 provides that section 5 came into operation on 17 February 1988 and that the rest of the Act comes into operation on 1 January 1989.

Clause 3 provides that the Principal Act is the Shop Trading Act 1987.

Clause 4 provides that various sections of the Principal Act be amended to provide for the removal of references to registration and makes other consequential amendments.

Clause 5 provides for a minor amendment of section 32 of the Act.
