Victorian Public Offices Corporation (Repeal) Bill EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Bill repeals the Victorian Public Offices Corporation Act 1974, makes consequential amendment to various other Acts and provides for other related matters.

Clause 1 sets out the purposes of the Bill.

Clause 2 is the commencement provision. Apart from the proposed section 6, which is deemed to have come into operation on 11 May 1989, the Bill comes into operation on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Clause 3 repeals the Victorian Public Offices Corporation Act 1974.

Clause 4 makes consequential amendments to various other Acts.

Clause 5 dissolves the Victorian Public Offices Corporation (the "Corporation") and the State Accommodation Committee and abolishes the Public Offices Fund.

Clause 6 underlines the Corporation's authority to resolve to administratively wind itself up on 11 May 1989.
