**No. 14 of 1928.****AN ACT to amend the Bunbury Electric Lighting Act, 1911.***[Assented to 10th December, 1928.]*

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bunbury Electric Lighting Act Amendment Act, 1928*, and shall be read as one with the Bunbury Electric Lighting Act, 1911, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section four of the principal Act, as amended by the Act No. 12 of 1924, is hereby amended by substituting the words "thirty-five thousand pounds" for the words "twenty-five thousand pounds" in paragraph (b) of the first proviso in the said section. Amendment of s. 4.
