

LOTTERIES (CONTROL).

No. 46 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1954-1967.

[Assented to 8th October, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Lotteries (Control) Act Amendment Act, 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1954-1967, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Lotteries (Control) Act, 1954-1970.

2. Subsection (2) of section 9 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the words "Commonwealth Inscribed Stock or in any security if the repayment of the moneys thereby secured is guaranteed by the Crown in right of the State", in lines eleven to fourteen inclusive, the words "any investments authorised by law as those in which trust funds may be invested".

3. Subsection (1) of section 10 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the word "prizes", being the last word in paragraph (b), the words "or tickets in lotteries being conducted by the Commission".
