AN ACT to appropriate certain Sums of Money A.D. 1883.
for certain Public Works.

[29 October, 1883.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of the unexpended balance of the moneys raised by Debentures under the Act of the 44th *Victoria*, No. 34, and out of the unexpended balance of the moneys raised by Debentures under the Act of the 45th *Victoria*, No. 38, for the purposes of "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," to appropriate the sums hereinafter mentioned for the purposes hereinafter specified ; that is to say, Appropriation out of unexpended balances of moneys raised under former Acts.

Moneys payable by Warrant of the Governor.

2 The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor, by any Warrant under his hand, from time to time, orders and directs; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the said unexpended balances.

Credit to be given to the Treasurer in account.

3 The said Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his Accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such Warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said Accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
