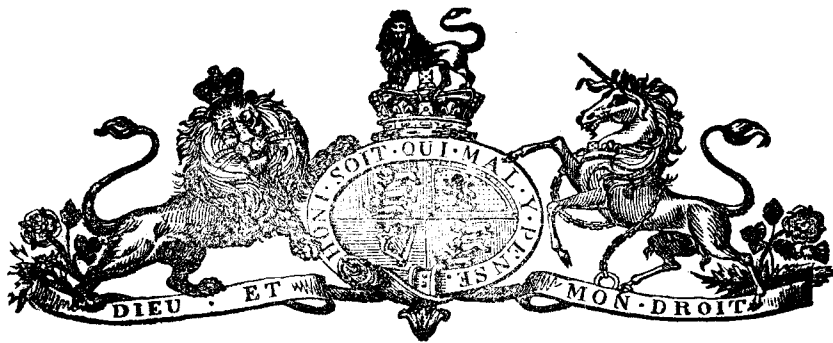

AN ACT to provide for the Erection and A.D. 1883.  
 Construction of certain Public Buildings.  
 [29 October, 1883.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause Minister of Lands the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to be erected, constructed, and completed, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such Work. to cause Works to be constructed.

**2** The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys Defrayment of provided by Parliament for that purpose. cost of Works.
