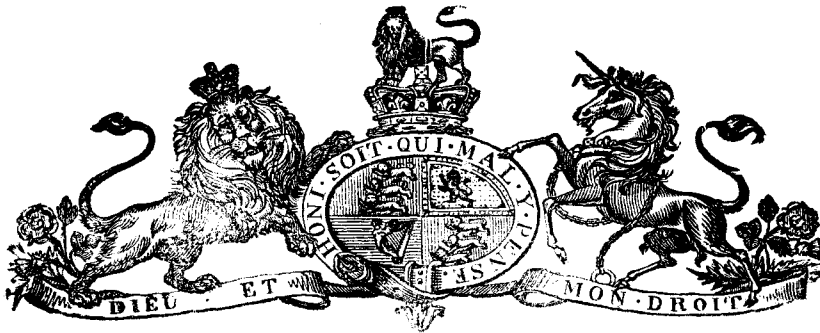
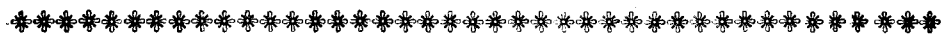

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain A.D. 1883.  
Public Works. [29 October, 1883.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause Minister to cause to be executed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost Works to be executed for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.

2 The cost of the several Works specified in the Schedule shall be Defrayment of defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by Parliament for that cost of Works. purpose.

3 This Act, and “The Public Works Construction Act, 1883,” shall Acts to be read be read and construed together as one Act. together.
