AN ACT to amend the *Education Act 1932*.
 [16 October 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act (No. 2)* Short title and citation.
 1973.

(2) The *Education Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section forty-nine of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Part V thereof:—

Special grants
to private
schools.

“ 49A—(1) Out of moneys provided by Parliament out of the Consolidated Revenue for the purpose the Minister shall in respect of any year pay a special grant to the governing body of each school to which a capitation grant is paid in respect of that year.

“(2) The amounts of the special grants paid to the governing bodies of schools under this section in respect of any year shall be proportional to the amounts of the capitation grants paid to those governing bodies in respect of that year.

“(3) Words and expressions used in this section have the same meaning as they have for the purposes of section forty-nine.”.
