AN ACT to further amend *The Police Act*, A.D. 1883.  
1865. [29 October, 1883.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend *The Police Act*, 1865, PREAMBLE.  
in certain particulars:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.  
“The said Act” means *The Police Act*, 1865. 29 Vict. No. 10.

2 The power conferred upon every Municipal Council by the Two Power to make  
hundred and Sixtieth Section of the said Act is hereby declared to Bye-laws.  
extend to the making, publishing, altering, modifying, amending, and  
repealing Bye-laws—

For regulating the inspection and use of Steam Engines within  
any Municipality:

For regulating the use of Bicycles and Tricycles and like vehicles  
within any Municipality:

For regulating the traffic and charges of Parcel Delivery Carts and  
other Vehicles used for like purposes, and the licensing of such  
Carts and Vehicles and their Drivers respectively, and the fees  
to be paid in respect of such Licences:

and also the appointing by such Bye-laws such penalties as the Council  
deems necessary, not exceeding Ten Pounds in any case, for enforcing  
such Bye-laws.

3 The said Act and every Act altering or amending the same, and Acts to be read  
this Act, shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and together.  
construed together as one Act.

4 This Act may be cited as “The Police Act Amendment Act, Short title.  
1883.”
